Observations

The number of salmon caught in 2012 was less than 2011, the numbers are back to the averages for the previous years with the exception of 2010 which was the highest ever recorded. July, August and September being the most productive months.

The comments made in the Sea Trout observations equally apply to the Salmon statistics.

The heaviest Salmon was 16 lbs caught by Mark Ryan and two 13lb salmon caught by Andrew Davies. Credit must be given to those members who released their Salmon achieving a 83% return rate.
