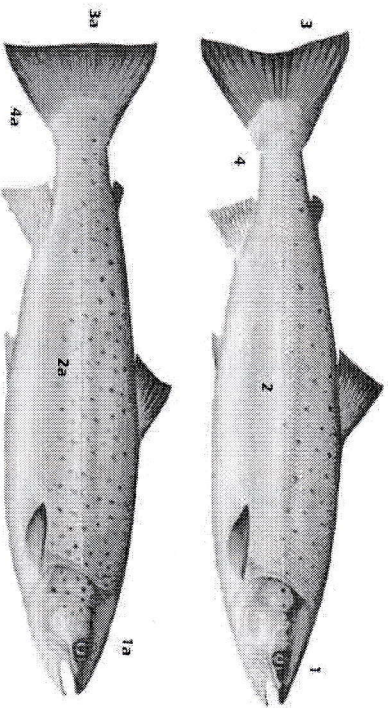

Salmo Salar - The Atlantic Salmon



Salmo Trutta - The Sea Trout

- Atlantic Salmon**
1. The Salmon's eye extends no further than the mouth
 2. There are few markings below the fishes lateral line
 3. The tail of a Salmon is concave
 4. The Salmon has a narrow tail base with a noticable wrist

- Sea Trout**
- 1a. The Sea Trout's eye extends further than its mouth
 - 2a. Larger number of markings below lateral line
 - 3a. The Tail of a Sea Trout will be Square, even convex (immature Sea Trout may have a concave tail)
 - 4a. The tail base is wide, with no noticable wrist.

Do not rely on a single feature for identification
Compare them all
